4. Title: Release of persons from commitment on parole supervision.

5. Summary: Requires the court services unit to consult with the local department of social services at least 90 days prior to a person's release from the Department of Juvenile Justice's commitment to develop a plan that prepares the person for successful transition from the Department's commitment to the custody of the local department of social services. Under current law, the court services unit shall make such consultation four weeks prior to such person's release.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Juvenile Justice, the legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact.
