	The bill also amends the definition of "qualifying project" in the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 (§ 56-575.1 et seq.) to require that the project be totally supported by private funds.

7.	Fiscal Impact Estimates: 7a. Expenditure Impact: Cannot be determined, see question 8.

Fiscal Implications: The amendment in the bill that would require all construction projects under \$25 million to use the standard design-bid-build procurement process or the alternate process of design-build, would remove the flexibility for the Commonwealth to determine if a project would benefit from the CM alternate procurement process. It is unknown how this would impact the cost of affected projects, if at all.
