Summary:** Requires the State Water Control Board to develop standards for facilities with aboveground storage tanks located in a city surrounded by a county wherein the urban county executive form of government is in effect, having an aggregate capacity of one million gallons or greater to upgrade to meet best practices standards for new or retrofitted tanks. The tanks have to meet these performance standards by July 1, 2021.
