Fiscal Implications: The Department of Corrections (DOC), in conjunction with the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), has compiled a list of GPS devices that could be used as a monitoring tracking device. This bill simply allows for use of GPS units or similar devices in lieu of incarceration in certain cases. There is no fiscal impact on state agencies as a result of this legislation.
