4. Title: Funding for construction of industrial access railroad tracks.

5. Summary: The Department of Rail and Public Transportation administers a program to facilitate the constructing or improving railroad access for industrial sites. The proposed legislation would amend the limit on the allocation of funds to localities for construction of industrial access railroad tracks. Currently, counties, cities, and towns may not receive in any one fiscal year more than 25 percent of available funds. The proposed bill would prohibit localities from receiving more than 50 percent of the funds.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed amendments would give the Commonwealth Transportation Board more flexibility in distributing funds for the rail access projects.
