Summary:** The enrolled bill expands the definition of podiatry to include the diagnosis and treatment of lower extremity ulcers, provided that the treatment of severe lower extremity ulcers proximal to the foot and ankle only be performed by appropriately trained, credentialed podiatrists in an approved hospitals or ambulatory surgery center at which the podiatrist has privileges.
