5. Summary: Authorizes the Governor to direct the State Treasurer to cause to be minted gold, platinum and silver coins for commemorative use that bear the seals of the Commonwealth.

8. Fiscal Implications: Coins for currency or commerce are being processed and produced in government coin mints. Private mints produce custom made and collectable coins such as commemorative coins. If the Governor directs the State Treasurer to implement a commemorative coin program, any costs or revenue that may be generated are indeterminate.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of the Treasury, Secretary of the Commonwealth, and the Department of General Services.
