**4. Title:** Information Technology Advisory Council; technology application framework

**5. Summary:** The bill requires the Information Technology Advisory Council (ITAC) to advise the Chief Information Officer on the creation of a technology application governance framework through which executive branch agencies can address agency business needs with potential information technology solutions. Agency leaders and information technology managers shall participate with ITAC in the design of this framework.
