Summary: This bill authorizes issuance of special license plates to applicants with as diabetes, epilepsy, heart disease, and paralysis. These plates would be subject to a one fee of \$15 and would be exempt from the standard 350 minimum-order requirement.  6. Fiscal impact estimates: Indeterminate. See Item #8.  7. Budget amendment necessary: No.  8. Fiscal implications: This bill creates six separate plates, at a total initial programming production cost estimate of \$28,850. Ordinarily, the Department of Motor Vehicles of expect to develop and produce a special license plate within the first fiscal year of the authorization. However, due to the requirement for regulations to be promulgated in 6 for these plates to be issued, the actual development and production of these plates will years to get through the regulatory process.  The Department of Motor Vehicles may not generate sufficient revenue to cover the content in the properties of the plates. Most special license plates are authorized subject to a 350 prepaid applications requirement. Those prepaid applications allow the agency to reconsts associated with the development and initial production of the plates. These plate exempt from both the prepaid application and minimum active set requirements. In account of the plates are not subject to an annual fee.  9.
