4. Title: State agencies; reports by executive branch entities to General Assembly

5. Summary: Reports by executive branch entities to the General Assembly. Authorizes state entities required to submit a report to multiple legislative branch entities to develop a consolidated report containing all required information. Such report shall be (i) formatted in compliance with the specific reporting requirements and (ii) provided in a manner designed to clearly delineate each legislative branch entity for which specific information is provided.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would require more staff time from agencies in the first year as the new format was created and reports were moved into it. In the following years, costs for creating and submitting these reports should be reduced as duplication of effort is eliminated.
