3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Elections; acquisition of voting equipment by localities.

5. Summary: Allows the purchase of direct recording electronic machines from any source to meet legal mandates to provide accessible voting equipment. Further provides the Secretary of the State Board with the authority to reject DRE acquisitions beyond those necessary to satisfy the accessible voting requirements specified by § [24.2-626.1](#). Current law requires these purchases to be made from existing DRE inventories within the Commonwealth.
