5. Summary: A person driving a motor vehicle is guilty of reckless driving if the person fails to stop such vehicle when approaching a bus which is stopped.

8. Fiscal Implications: A fiscal impact is not expected due to this legislation. It was recently uncovered in a court case that an error occurred in 1970 when language was amended. The court case identified the ongoing misinterpretation of the existing language. Subsequently, the case resulted in a finding of not guilty. This legislation corrects the amended language.
