8.	Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of the bill is indeterminate. However, DHCD anticipates that the provisions of the bill may encourage more participation from eligible entities, but would not have a significant fiscal impact. HB1500/SB800 includes \$13.2 million in FY 2012, from the general fund, for payments under the Virginia Enterprise Zone Program. In the event demand for grants under the program exceeds the amount of available funding, the Department is authorized to prorate payouts, or program benefits.
