8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> Section 2.2-2813 of the Code of Virginia provides that members of boards, commissions, committees, councils and other collegial bodies, who are appointed at the state level, be compensated at a rate of \$50 per day, unless a different compensation is specified by statute for such members, plus expenses for each day or portion of the day in which the member is engaged in the business of that body.  However, \$4-5.01 C. of Chapter 874, 2010 Acts of Assembly, overrides that statute by prohibiting executive branch agencies from making a per diem payment to members of boards or commissions from any fund. Therefore, agencies and institutions cannot pay the \$50 per diem amount specified in \$2.2-2813 of the Code of Virginia, but can reimburse for other expenses.						
	The proposed legislation may cause institutions of higher education to incur some increased costs related to travel and housing by adding two additional members to the Board of
