4. Title: Video-monitoring system; school bus violations.

5. Summary: Allows local school boards to authorize the installation and use of operate video monitoring systems on or inside school buses.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation permits local school divisions to authorize the installation and use of video monitoring systems on or inside school buses. It is anticipated that any local school division that chooses to operate a video-monitoring system may incur additional costs; however, this legislation does not require the Commonwealth to provide any funding to support such a system so there will be no state fiscal impact.
