| 12 | § 19.2-80.3. Arrestee to be advised of rights on arrest in arrestee's native language. |
| 13 | When a person accused of a criminal offense is placed under arrest and advised (i) of his right to |
| 14 | remain silent, (ii) that anything he says may be used against him in a court of law, (iii) that he has a |
| 15 | right to the presence of an attorney during any interviews, and (iv) that if he cannot afford an attorney, |
| 16 | one will be appointed for him prior to any questioning, the arresting officer or officers shall so advise |
| 17 | the arrestee in his native language in a manner that ensures that the arrestee fully comprehends his |
| 18 | rights including, if necessary, by providing the information in the arrestee's native language in verbal or |
