10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 51.1-205 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 51.1-205. Service retirement generally.
14	A. Normal retirement Any member in service at his normal retirement date with five or more years
15	of creditable service (i) as a member in the retirement system established by this chapter, (ii) as a
16	member in the retirement system established by Chapter 2.1 (§ 51.1-211 et seq.) of this title, or (iii)
17	while earning the benefits permitted by § 51.1-138 may retire upon written notification to the Board,
18	setting forth the date the retirement is to become effective. Any member, except one appointed by the
19	Governor or elected by the people, or a regional jail or jail farm superintendent, who attains 70 years
20	of age shall be retired within 60 days of attaining age 70. Any employer, subsequent to the employee's
21 22	normal retirement date, may provide for compulsory service retirement upon a determination that age is a bona fide occupational qualification reasonably necessary to the normal operation of the particular
$\frac{22}{23}$	business or that the employee is incapable of performing his duties in a safe and efficient manner. Any
23 24	such determination shall be made by the employer.
25	Effective December 31, 2003, any member in service on June 30, 2002, and July 1, 2002, who is
26	credited with five or more years of creditable service rendered under Chapter 1 (§ 51.1-100 et seq.), this
27	chapter, or Chapter 2.1 (§ 51.1-211 et seq.) of this title shall not be subject to the vesting requirements
28	of this section, and §§ 51.1-138 and 51.1-216.
29	B. Early retirement Any member in service who has attained his fiftieth birthday with five or more
30	years of creditable service (i) as a member in the retirement system established by this chapter, (ii) as a

38	C. Deferred retirement for members terminating service Any member who terminates service after
39	five or more years of creditable service (i) as a member in the retirement system established by this
40	chapter, (ii) as a member in the retirement system established by Chapter 2.1 (§ 51.1-211 et seq.) of this
41 42	title, or (iii) while earning the benefits permitted by § 51.1-138, may retire under the provisions of subsection A, B, or D of this section if he has not withdrawn his accumulated contributions prior to the
43	effective date of his retirement or if he has five or more years of creditable service (a) as a member in
44	the retirement system established by this chapter, (b) as a member in the retirement system established
45	by Chapter 2.1 (§ 51.1-211 et seq.) of this title, or (c) while earning the benefits permitted by
46	§ 51.1-138, regardless of termination date, for which his employer has paid the contributions and such
47	contributions cannot be withdrawn. For the purposes of this subsection, any requirements as to the
48	member being in service shall not apply.
<b>49</b>	Effective December 31, 2003, any member in service on June 30, 2002, and July 1, 2002, who is
50 51	credited with five or more years of creditable service rendered under Chapter 1 (§ 51.1-100 et seq.), this chapter or Chapter 2.1 (§ 51.1-211 et seq.) of this title shall not be subject to the vesting requirements

52 53	D. Effective date of retirement The effective date of retirement shall be after the last day of

56	written notification of his intention to retire, the member's appointing authority may submit notification
57	on his behalf.
