If an ordinance is enacted by a locality in accordance with this chapter, it may provide that 12 13 management shall designate reasonable no-smoking areas, considering the nature of the use and the size of the building, in the following places: 14 1. Retail and service establishments of 15,000 square feet or more serving the general public, 15 16 including, but not limited to, department stores, grocery stores, drug stores, clothing stores, and shoe 17 2. Educational facilities, except as provided in § 15.2-2824; 18 19 3. Health care facilities; 20 4. Rooms in which a public meeting or hearing is being held; 21 5. Places of entertainment and cultural facilities, including but not limited to theaters, concert halls, 22 gymnasiums, auditoriums, other enclosed arenas, art galleries, libraries, and museums; 23 6. Indoor facilities used for recreational purposes; or 24 7. Other public places. 25

B. If an ordinance is enacted by a locality in accordance with this chapter, it may provide for a smoking ban in public parks designated by the locality. Appropriate signs shall be posted in accordance with § 15.2-2832 at each public entrance to such park.
