Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 23-281 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 23-281. Powers of the Board.

In order to carry out its purpose, the Board shall have the power to:

10 1. Make grants or other expenditures or disbursements from the Fund to provide support for research efforts approved by the Board in accordance with the purposes of this chapter; however, the Board shall 11 12 not be obligated to make annual or other periodic disbursements or expenditures;

13 2. Contract for the services of consultants to review research proposals and to assist in the evaluation 14 of the research efforts funded by the Board;

15 3. Contract for other professional services to assist the Board in the performance of its duties and 16 responsibilities;

- 4. Accept, hold, administer, and solicit gifts, grants, bequests, contributions or other assistance from 17 federal agencies, the Commonwealth, or any other public or private source to carry out the purposes of 18 19 this chapter;
- 20 5. Enter into any agreement or contract relating to the acceptance or use of any grant, assistance or 21 support provided by or to the Board, or otherwise in furtherance of the purposes of this chapter; 22

6. Perform any lawful acts necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes of the Board; and

23 7. Employ such staff as is necessary to perform the Board's duties. The Board may determine the duties of such staff and fix the salaries and compensation of such staff, which shall be paid from the 24 25 Fund. Such staff shall be an employee of the Department of Accounts and shall be entitled to all 26 benefits available to state employees as provided by law.

27 2. That the Commonwealth Health Research Board shall enter into a memorandum of 28 understanding with the Department of Accounts concerning staff support to the Board hired 29 pursuant to subdivision 7 of § 23-281 of the Code of Virginia. Nothing in this act shall be construed to limit the Board's authority to hire such staff as it deems necessary, nor shall this act 30 31 be interpreted to alter the source of funding of the salaries and compensation of such staff from the Commonwealth Health Research Fund. 32
