6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 19.2-340.1, relating to disposition
7	of fines and forfeitures.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 19.2-340.1 as follows:
10	§ 19.2-340.1. Disposition of fines in criminal cases.
11	A. In a county, city, or town whose governing body lawfully adopts an ordinance that imposes a
12	criminal penalty, all fines and forfeitures collected upon conviction or upon forfeiture of bail of any
13	person for a violation of the ordinance shall be paid into the county, city, or town treasury. Fees shall
14	be disposed of according to law.
15	B. When a law-enforcement officer of (i) the Department of State Police or (ii) any other division of
16	the state government makes an arrest or issues a summons for a violation of a provision of the Code of
17	Virginia, the person arrested or summoned shall be charged with and tried for a violation of that Code
18	provision and shall not be charged with and tried for a substantially similar local ordinance. All fines
19	and forfeitures collected upon conviction or upon forfeiture of bail of any person so arrested or
20	summoned shall be credited to the Literary Fund.
