	That § 10.1-1114 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12 12	§ 10.1-1114. Establishment of nurseries; distribution of seeds and seedlings; phytosanitary certificate
	A. The State Forester may establish and maintain a nursery or nurseries, for the propagation of forest
	e seedlings, either upon one or more of the forest reservations of the Commonwealth, or upon such
	her land as he may and which he is empowered to acquire for that purpose. Seedlings from this
	rsery may be furnished to the Commonwealth without expense for use upon its state forests or other
	blic grounds or parks. Seeds and seedlings may also be distributed to landowners and citizens of the
	ommonwealth pursuant to Department regulations.
20	B. To ensure pest and disease-free plant material, and to the extent permitted by federal law and
	gulations, the preferred method of treatment shall be fumigation using methyl bromide in seedling
	ant beds prior to seeding.
23	C. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services may issue a phytosanitary certificate or a
	rmit for intrastate and interstate shipments of conifer and hardwood seedlings to verify that they are
