10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-383 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-383. Exceptions to application of article.
13	Nothing With the exception of §§ 18.2-374.1, 18.2-374.1:1, and 18.2-374.3, nothing contained in this
14	article shall be construed to apply to:
15	(1) The purchase, distribution, exhibition, or loan of any book, magazine, or other printed or
16	manuscript material by any library, school, or institution of higher learning, supported by public
17	appropriation;
18	(2) The purchase, distribution, exhibition, or loan of any work of art by any museum of fine arts,
19	school, or institution of higher learning, supported by public appropriation; and
20	(3) The exhibition or performance of any play, drama, tableau, or motion picture by any theatre,
21	museum of fine arts, school or institution of higher learning, supported by public appropriation.
22	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
23	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0

for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
