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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-2816.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-2816.1. Continuing education requirements; promulgation of regulations.
13	A. The Board shall promulgate regulations governing continuing education requirements for funeral
14	services licensees, funeral directors and embalmers licensed by the Board.
15	B. The Board shall approve criteria for continuing education courses, requiring no more than 10
16	hours over two years five hours per year, that are directly related to the respective license and scope of
17	practice of funeral service licensees, funeral directors and embalmers. Approved continuing education
18	courses shall include, but not be limited to, at least one hour per year covering compliance with <i>federal</i>
19	or state laws and regulations governing the profession, and at least one hour per year covering preneed
20	funeral arrangements. Course providers may be required to register continuing education courses with
21	the Board pursuant to Board regulations. The Board shall not allow continuing education credit for
22	courses where the principal purpose of the course is to promote, sell or offer goods, products or services
23	to funeral homes.
24	C. All course providers shall furnish written certification to licensees of the Board attending and
25	completing respective courses, indicating the satisfactory completion of an approved continuing
26	education course. Each course provider shall retain records of all persons attending and those persons
27	satisfactorily completing such continuing education courses for a period of two years following each
28	course. Applicants for renewal or reinstatement of licenses issued pursuant to this article shall retain for
29	a period of two years the written certification issued by any Board-approved provider of continuing
30	education courses. The Board may require course providers or licensees to submit copies of such records

31 or certification, as it deems necessary, to ensure compliance with continuing education requirements. 32 D. The Board shall have the authority to grant exemptions or waivers in cases of certified illness or 33 undue hardship.

34 E. The Board may provide for an inactive status for those licensees who do not practice in Virginia. The Board may adopt regulations reducing or waiving continuing education requirements for any licensee granted such inactive status. However, no licensee granted inactive status may have their license 35 36 37 changed to active status without first obtaining additional continuing education hours as may be determined by the Board. No person or registrant shall practice in Virginia as an embalmer, funeral 38 39 director, or funeral service licensee unless he holds a current, active license.
