2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 29.1-702 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the expiration date of*
3 *motorboat registration.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 29.1-702 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 29.1-702. Registration requirements; display of numbers; cancellation of certificate; exemption.

9 A. 1. The owner of each motorboat requiring numbering by the Commonwealth shall file an
10 application for a number with the Department on forms approved by it. The owner of the motorboat or
11 the owner's agent shall sign the application and pay the following boat registration fee:

12 a. For a motorboat under sixteen feet, eighteen dollars;

13 b. For a motorboat sixteen feet to less than twenty feet, twenty-two dollars;

14 c. For a motorboat twenty feet to less than forty feet, twenty-eight dollars;

15 d. For a motorboat forty feet and over, thirty-six dollars.

16 2. Owners, other than manufacturers or dealers, of more than ten motorboats numbered by the
17 Commonwealth, shall pay eighteen dollars each for the first ten such boats and twelve dollars for each
18 additional boat.

19 3. Upon receipt of the application in approved form, the Department shall have the application
20 entered upon the records of its office and issue to the applicant a certificate of number stating the
21 identification number awarded to the motorboat and the name, address and a social security number or
22 numbers, or federal tax identification number of the owner or owners. Any certificate issued in
23 accordance with this chapter shall expire three years from the ~~first~~ last day of the month in which it was
24 issued. Upon proper application and payment of fee, and in the discretion of the Director, the certificate
25 may be renewed.

26 B. The owner shall paint on or attach to each side of the bow of the motorboat the identification
27 number in the manner prescribed by rules and regulations of the Board. The number shall be maintained
28 in legible condition. The certificate of number shall be pocket-size and shall be available for inspection
29 on the motorboat for which issued whenever such motorboat is in operation. However, the certificate of
30 number for any vessel less than twenty-six feet in length, and leased or rented to another for the lessee's
31 noncommercial use for less than twenty-four hours, may be retained on shore by the vessel's owner or
32 his representative at the place at which the vessel departs and returns to the possession of the owner or
33 his representative, provided the vessel is appropriately identified as to its owner while in use under such
34 lease or rental.

35 C. No number other than the number awarded to a motorboat or granted reciprocity pursuant to this
36 chapter shall be displayed on either side of the bow of the motorboat.

37 D. The Department is authorized to cancel and recall any certificate of number issued by the
38 Department when it appears proper payment has not been made for the certificate of number or when
39 the certificate has been improperly or erroneously issued.

40 E. Any motorboat purchased and used by a nonprofit volunteer rescue squad or volunteer fire
41 department shall be exempt from the registration fees imposed by subsection A of this section.
