10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 53.1-79.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 53.1-79.1. Agreements to transfer, transport, and confine prisoners.
13	The sheriff or superintendent of any jail local correctional facility may enter into an agreement with
14	the sheriff or superintendent of any other jail local correctional facility in the Commonwealth to transfer
15	and transport prisoners between the respective facilities, and to confine such prisoners, unless such
16	transfer is otherwise prohibited by law.
17	The sheriff or superintendent of any local correctional facility may enter into an agreement with the
18	Department to transfer local inmates to any state facility for confinement. Each agreement shall provide
19	for the payment by the sheriff or regional jail authority of all reasonable costs of guarding, feeding,
20	alathing againg for and furnishing of madicing and madical attention to such prisonants Immates

clothing, caring for, and furnishing of medicine and medical attention to such prisoners. Inmates transferred under the provisions of this subsection shall be kept separate from the population of 20 21 22

prisoners committed by the court to the custody of the Director of the Department under § 53.1-20.
