- A. Any single contribution of \$500 or more for a General Assembly office knowingly received or reported by the candidate or his treasurer on and after January 1 and before the commencement of the regular session of the General Assembly in that year shall be reported in writing as provided in §§ 24.2-947.4 and 24.2-947.5 or electronically pursuant to § 24.2-946.1, and the report shall be received by the State Board by 5:00 p.m. on the day following receipt of the contribution, or for a contribution received on a Saturday by 5:00 p.m. on the following Monday. However, any such contribution received within the 24 hours prior to the commencement of the session shall be reported and a report thereof received prior to, or within one hour after, the commencement of the session.
- B. Any contribution reported pursuant to this section shall also be reported on the report required by this article to be filed on January 15 of the same year.
