| 10 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 11 12 | 1. That § 2.2-3900 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 2.2-3900. Short title; declaration of policy. |
| 12 | A. This chapter shall be known and cited as the Virginia Human Rights Act. |
| 13 14 | B. It is the policy of the Commonwealth to: |
| 15 | 1. Safeguard all individuals within the Commonwealth from unlawful discrimination because of race, |
| 16 | color, religion, national origin, sex, pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions, age, marital |
| 17 | status, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability, in places of public accommodation, including |
| 18 | educational institutions and in real estate transactions; in employment; preserve the public safety, health |
| 19 | and general welfare; and further the interests, rights and privileges of individuals within the |
| 20 | Commonwealth; and |
| 21 | 2. Protect citizens of the Commonwealth against unfounded charges of unlawful discrimination. |
| 22 | C. For the purposes of this section: |
| 23 | "Gender identity" means an individual's self-conception as being male or female, as distinguished |
| 24 | from actual biological sex. |
| 25 | "Sexual orientation" means a person's actual or perceived heterosexuality, bisexuality, or |
| 26 | homosexuality. Sexual orientation shall not include any person's attraction toward persons with whom |

27 sexual conduct would be illegal due to the age of the parties.
