2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 58.1-802 of the Code of Virginia, relating to recordation tax.*

5 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**6 **1. That § 58.1-802 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

7 § 58.1-802. Additional tax paid by grantor; collection.

8 A. In addition to any other tax imposed under the provisions of this chapter, a tax is hereby imposed
9 on each deed, instrument, or writing by which lands, tenements or other realty sold is granted, assigned,
10 transferred, or otherwise conveyed to, or vested in the purchaser, or any other person, by such
11 purchaser's direction. The rate of the tax, when the consideration or value of the interest, whichever is
12 greater, exceeds \$100, shall be 50 cents for each \$500 or fraction thereof, exclusive of the value of any
13 lien or encumbrance remaining thereon at the time of the sale, whether such lien is assumed or the
14 realty is sold subject to such lien or encumbrance. No increase in the city or county recordation tax
15 authorized by § 58.1-814 shall be deemed authorized by this section.

16 The tax imposed by this section shall be paid by the grantor, or any person who signs on behalf of
17 the grantor, of any deed, instrument or writing subject to the tax imposed by this section.

18 No such deed, instrument or other writing shall be admitted to record ~~without~~ *unless (i) the amount*
19 *of the consideration is stated on the first page of the document to be admitted to record and (ii)*
20 *certification of the clerk of the court wherein first recorded having has* been affixed thereto that the tax
21 imposed by this section has been paid. The clerk shall include within the certificate the amount of such
22 tax collected thereon.

23 B. Taxes imposed by this section shall be collected as provided in § 58.1-812 and the clerk shall
24 return taxes collected hereunder one-half into the state treasury and one-half into the treasury of the
25 locality.

26 The local portion of the tax imposed by this section on property which is located in more than one
27 jurisdiction shall be collected by the clerk in proportion to the value of the property located in each such
28 locality when recorded therein.

29 Every clerk of court collecting taxes under this section for the county or city which he serves shall
30 be entitled to compensation for such service at five percent of the amount so collected and paid.
