6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-51.6 as follows:**

8 *§ 18.2-51.6. Strangulation of another; penalty.*

9 *Any person who, without consent, impedes the blood circulation or respiration of another person by*
10 *knowingly, intentionally and unlawfully applying pressure to the neck of such person, resulting in the*
11 *wounding or bodily injury of such person is guilty of strangulation, a Class 6 felony.*

12 **2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or**
13 **commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot**
14 **be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter**
15 **890 of the Acts of Assembly of 2011 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to**
16 **assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the**
17 **necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the**
18 **Department of Juvenile Justice.**
