6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 29.1-302.02 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 29.1-302.02. Special resident and nonresident hunting and fishing licenses for partially disabled
9 veterans.

10 A. Any resident veteran who is rated by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having at least a
11 70 percent service-connected disability, upon certification, shall pay an amount equal to one-half the fee
12 for the state resident basic hunting license required by subdivision 2 of § 29.1-303. Any nonresident
13 veteran who is similarly rated, upon certification, shall pay an amount equal to one-half the fee for the
14 state nonresident license required by subdivision 3 of § 29.1-303. The license fees established by this
15 section may be revised by the Board pursuant to § 29.1-103.

16 B. Any resident veteran who is rated by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having at least a
17 70 percent service-connected disability, upon certification, shall pay an amount equal to one-half the fee
18 for the state resident basic fishing license required by subdivision A 2 of § 29.1-310. Any nonresident
19 veteran who is similarly rated, upon certification, shall pay an amount equal to one-half the fee for the
20 state nonresident license required by subdivision A 3 of § 29.1-310. The license fees established by this
21 section may be revised by the Board pursuant to § 29.1-103.
