12 A. It shall be the duty of every operator of a vessel involved in a collision or acci	dent or other
13 casualty to stop and render assistance as required by subsection A of § 29.1-739. If any $pe$	
14 knowingly fails to comply with the provisions of subsection A of § 29.1-739 when	
15 accident or other casualty results in serious bodily injury to, or the death of, any person,	
16 guilty of a Class 6 felony. If any person operator knowingly fails to comply with the
