| 11 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-91.1 as follows:                |
| 12 | § 18.2-91.1. Use of physical force, including deadly force, against an intruder; justified self-defense.  |
| 13 | Any person who lawfully occupies a dwelling is justified in using any degree of physical force,           |
| 14 | including deadly physical force, against another person when (i) the other person has unlawfully entered  |
| 15 | the dwelling and has committed an overt act toward the occupant or another person in the dwelling and     |
| 16 | (ii) the occupant reasonably believes he or another person in the dwelling is in imminent danger of       |
| 17 | bodily injury.  |
| 18 | Any occupant of a dwelling using physical force, including deadly physical force, as provided in this     |
| 19 | section shall be immune from civil liability for injuries or death of the other person who has unlawfully |
