10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-857 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-857. Driving two abreast in a single lane.
13	A person shall be guilty of reckless driving who drives any motor vehicle, including any motorcycle,
14	so as to be abreast of another vehicle in a lane designed for one vehicle, or drives any motor vehicle,
15	including any motorcycle, so as to travel abreast of any other vehicle traveling in a lane designed for
16	one vehicle. However Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit two motorcycles from
17	traveling abreast while traveling in a lane designated for one vehicle. In addition, this section shall not
18	apply to (i) any validly authorized parade, motorcade, or motorcycle escort, or law-enforcement officers
19	driving motorcycles while on official duty; (ii) a motor vehicle traveling in the same lane of traffic as a
20	bicycle, electric personal assistive mobility device, electric power-assisted bicycle, or moped; nor shall it
21	apply to (iii) any vehicle when lawfully overtaking and passing one or more vehicles traveling in the
22	same direction in a separate lane.
