HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 167

Commending the Poquoson Little League 9 - 10 Baseball All-Star team.

WHEREAS, under the leadership of manager Shaun Brown and coaches Mike Jackson and Marvin Holloway, the Poquoson Little League 9 - 10 Baseball All-Star team exhibited great talent, spirit, team work, and sportsmanship; and

WHEREAS, the Poquoson Little League All-Star teams enjoyed a remarkable 2011 season with the 9 - 10, 10 - 11, and 11 - 12 teams all taking home the District 7 titles and representing the district at state competition, a coveted triple crown believed to be the first for Poquoson Little League; now, therefore, be it
