WHEREAS, Mary Ann Buffington presided over Captain Buzzy's with a positive outlook, a sunny disposition, and a rapier wit, and the store's customers deeply appreciated the owners' endeavors to make the coffee shop a social hub of the community; and

WHEREAS, part of what made Captain Buzzy's special was Mary Ann Buffington's homemade desserts and scones; the restaurant's red velvet cake was featured in *Virginia Living* magazine; and

WHEREAS, Mary Ann Buffington's other interests included bird watching, gardening, travel, and watching the *Wheel of Fortune* television show; she was thrilled when she appeared on the show in 2003 and was the winning contestant; and

WHEREAS, Mary Ann Buffington is survived by her devoted husband, Robert S. Buffington II; her stepdaughter Natalie, whom she loved dearly; she will be fondly remembered by other family members, and the many friends, neighbors, and customers of Captain Buzzy's; now, therefore, be it
