- WHEREAS, in addition to raising her family, Beatrice Christian worked as a valued employee at the
   Norfolk Redevelopment and Housing Authority; Norfolk Department of Recreation, Parks and Open
   Space; *New Journal and Guide*; and what is now Norfolk State University; and
- WHEREAS, Beatrice Christian took an active role in community affairs through her membership at
