7 Special Olympics World Summer Games, captured a bronze medal in the 1,500-meter race and won

9 WHEREAS, over 7,500 athletes traveled to the historic city of Athens, Greece, to participate in the
2011 Special Olympics World Summer Games held June 25 - July 4, 2011; and

11 WHEREAS, a graduate of South Lakes High School, Rose Pleskow maintained honor roll status 12 while also pursuing her love of track and field and competing in sailing, cross-country skiing, and 13 swimming; and

WHEREAS, Rose Pleskow has also volunteered with community service organizations such as the
 Epilepsy Foundation of Virginia's Northern Virginia office, the Reston Hospital Center, and the Fairfax
 County Park Authority; and

WHEREAS, a hardworking athlete, Rose Pleskow medaled in the 1,500- and 3,000-meter races at the
2010 Special Olympics Virginia Summer Games and won gold at the 2011 Special Olympics Virginia
Summer Games; and

WHEREAS, excited to be a part of the international competition, Rose Pleskow had the opportunity to meet fellow athletes and take in the sights and sounds of Greece before capturing a bronze medal in the 1,500-meter race and winning fourth place in the 800-meter race in the track and field competition; and
