WHEREAS, Patrick Hammes finished highest of any participant from the Mid-Atlantic states at the National Geographic Bee, a testament to his hard work and extensive knowledge; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Hammes, now an eighth grade student at Herndon Middle School, takes the

maximum number of honors classes offered and participates in the Technology Student Association; now, therefore, be it
