Celebrating the life of the Honorable Hal J. Bonney, Jr.

5 6 WHEREAS, the Honorable Hal J. Bonney, Jr., who served the citizens of the Commonwealth with great distinction as a federal bankruptcy judge for the United States District Court, Eastern District of Virginia for 25 years, died on January 22, 2012; and WHEREAS, as a young man, Hal Bonney had the unique opportunity to reside at the historic 7 8

9 Jefferson Hotel in Richmond, where his father was the food steward; and 10

WHEREAS, Hal Bonney graduated from John Marshall High School and earned bachelor's and 11 master's degrees from the University of Richmond before embarking on a career in education at Norview 12 High School; he also spent several years as the headmaster at Douglas MacArthur Academy; and 13

WHEREAS, Hal Bonney returned to school after several years of teaching to earn a law degree at 14 15 The College of William & Mary, while also continuing to teach in the evenings at The College of William & Mary, the University of Virginia, and Regent University; and 16

WHEREAS, while in law school, Hal Bonney developed a deep knowledge of and appreciation for 17 the law that would mark his career and profoundly shape his views; and 18

19 WHEREAS, Hal Bonney faithfully served the residents of the Eastern District Court of Virginia for 20 25 years as a judge, presiding with great fairness, integrity, and common sense until his retirement in 21 1995; and

WHEREAS, after years on the bench as a bankruptcy judge, Hal Bonney developed an admired head 22 23 for business affairs and, in retirement, became a certified movie producer and sought-after Hollywood 24 consultant; and

25 WHEREAS, a deeply spiritual man who desired to be of service to others, Hal Bonney took an active role in community and church affairs as a member of the board of visitors at Duke Divinity 26 27 School, commissioner for the City of Norfolk Recreation, Parks and Open Space Department, vice 28 president of Union Mission Ministries, member of Calvary Temple Church, and longtime teacher of the 29 Wesleymen Bible Class: and

30 WHEREAS, a devoted family man, Hal Bonney will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by 31 his sons, David and John, and their families and numerous other family members and friends; now, 32 therefore, be it

33 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring. That the General Assembly hereby 34 note with great sadness the loss of an admired jurist and community supporter, the Honorable Hal J. 35 Bonney, Jr.; and, be it

36 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 37 for presentation to the family of the Honorable Hal J. Bonney, Jr., as an expression of the General 38 Assembly's respect for his memory.
