WHEREAS, the Turner Ashby High School one-act play ensemble members chose to perform "The
 Anatomy of Gray" at the state competition, where they faced seven other one-act play ensembles from
 across the state; and

WHEREAS, "The Anatomy of Gray," set in the late 1800s, chronicles the events of a small Indiana
 town named Gray when a plague strikes local residents, and it provided members an opportunity to
 showcase their theatrical talents; and

WHEREAS, the Turner Ashby High School one-act play ensemble also performed "The Anatomy of
 Gray" at the Virginia Theatre Association Secondary School Festival, where they won first place,
 competing against 39 other schools; and
