2	AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

5	(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Cosgrove)
6	Designating the third Monday in January, in 2013 and in each succeeding year, as Virginia National
7	Guard Day in Virginia.
8	WHEREAS, the National Guard is the oldest component of the Armed Forces of the United States
9	and one of the nation's longest-enduring institutions; and
10	WHEREAS, Virginia traces the heritage and traditions of the selfless service of citizen soldiers to the
11	founding of the Jamestown Colony in 1607; and
12 13	WHEREAS, Presidents Washington, Jefferson, Madison, Monroe, and Tyler all served as officers in the Virginia militia; and
13 14	WHEREAS, the courageous soldiers and airmen of the Virginia National Guard have made
15	outstanding and valuable contributions to the defense of the United States and the security of the
16	Commonwealth and have advanced the cause of freedom around the world; and
17	WHEREAS, these same soldiers and airmen have put themselves in harm's way, fought bravely,
18	made great sacrifices, and provided an example of selfless service for all the citizens of the
19	Commonwealth and the nation; and
20	WHEREAS, from the American Revolution to the American Civil War, from World War I to D-Day,
21 22	from Operation Desert Storm to Iraq and Afghanistan, Virginia National Guard soldiers and airmen have
$\frac{22}{23}$	demonstrated unmatched courage, dedication, and willingness to sacrifice to accomplish any mission; and
23 24	WHEREAS, since the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, more than 14,000 Virginia National
25	Guard soldiers and airmen have served on federal active duty in support of Operation Noble Eagle,
26	Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom, and Operation New Dawn, helping to maintain
27	security in the United States and further the cause of freedom in Iraq and Afghanistan, including service
28	in the NATO peacekeeping mission in Bosnia and Kosovo; and
29	WHEREAS, Virginia National Guard soldiers and airmen responded to numerous floods, hurricanes,
30	snow storms, and other natural disasters to support state and local authorities to provide assistance to
31 32	citizens of the Commonwealth and citizens in neighboring states in their time of need; and WHEREAS, the Virginia National Guard strives to be a relevant and rapidly responding force that is
32 33	staffed, equipped, and trained to meet all federal and state requirements and is prepared to deploy as
34	directed by the Governor to assist state and local authorities to protect life and property and preserve
35	peace, order, and public safety; now, therefore, be it
36	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate
37	the third Monday in January, in 2013 and in each succeeding year, as Virginia National Guard Day in
38	Virginia; and, be it
39 40	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates post the designation of this day
40	on the General Assembly's website.
