WHEREAS, Annie Houston LeHardy, the 2010 - 2011 Gatorade Virginia Girls Cross Country
Runner of the Year, was a stand-out scholar-athlete for Hidden Valley High School in Roanoke County;
and

WHEREAS, Annie LeHardy's list of running achievements include winning the Virginia High School
 League Girls Cross Country Group AA state championship for 2010 - 2011, setting a course record time
 of 17 minutes and 34 seconds; and

WHEREAS, in her senior year at Hidden Valley High School, Annie LeHardy was chosen as
MileStat.com's cross country runner of the year; additionally she won the Group AA track and field
state championship in the 1,600 meter race with a time of 4 minutes and 57.07 seconds and holds a
school record in that event of 4 minutes and 55.84 seconds; and

WHEREAS, additional running awards include being named a finalist in 2009 and 2010 at the Nike
Cross Nationals meet, and receiving All-State honors in the 800 and 1,600 meter races for all four years
of high school; and
