10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 10.1-1114 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 10.1-1114. Establishment of nurseries; distribution of seeds and seedlings; phytosanitary certificate
12	issued by Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
13 14	<i>A.</i> The State Forester may establish and maintain a nursery or nurseries, for the propagation of forest
15	tree seedlings, either upon one or more of the forest reservations of the Commonwealth, or upon such
16	other land as he may and which he is empowered to acquire for that purpose. Seedlings from this
17	nursery may be furnished to the Commonwealth without expense for use upon its state forests or other
18	public grounds or parks. Seeds and seedlings may also be distributed to landowners and citizens of the
19	Commonwealth pursuant to Department regulations.
20	B. To ensure pest and disease-free plant material, and to the extent permitted by federal law and
21	regulations, the preferred method of treatment shall be fumigation using methyl bromide in seedling
22	plant beds prior to seeding.
23	C. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services may issue a phytosanitary certificate or a
24	permit for intrastate and interstate shipments of conifer and hardwood seedlings to verify that they are
25	free of pests and diseases.
