Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8 9 1. That §§ 2.2-1401 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: § 2.2-1401. Definitions. 10 11 As used in this chapter unless the context requires a different meaning: 12 "Certification" means the process by which a business is determined to be a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business for the purpose of reporting small, women-owned, and minority-owned 13 business participation in state contracts and purchases pursuant to §§ 2.2-1404 and 2.2-1405. 14 15 "Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident 16 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions: 1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and 17 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part. 18 2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, 19 20 Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China, 21 Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of the 22 Pacific, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, or Sri Lanka and who is regarded as such by the community of 23 which this person claims to be a part. 24 3. "Hispanic American" means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of 25 Mexico, South or Central America, or the Caribbean Islands or other Spanish or Portuguese cultures and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part. 26 4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America 27 28 and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is 29 recognized by a tribal organization. 30 "Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, 31 32 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and 33 34 35 daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals. 36 Small business" means a business located in Virginia that is at least 51% 51 percent independently 37 owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and 38 together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees, or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or 39 less averaged over the previous three years that meets the size standards established by the Administrator of the U.S. Small Business Administration pursuant to the federal Small Business Act (15 40 41 U.S.C. § 631 et seq.), as amended, and relevant regulations promulgated thereto. One or more of the 42 individual owners shall control both the management and daily business operations of the small business. A small business is located in Virginia if the business has been organized pursuant to Virginia 43 44 law or maintains a principle place of business within Virginia. "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other 45 unit of state government. "State agency" shall not include any county, city, or town. 46 47 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one or more **48** women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is 49 50 owned by one or more women who are citizens of the United States or legal resident aliens, and both 51 the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women. 52 § 2.2-4310. Discrimination prohibited; participation of small, women-owned, minority-owned, and 53 service disabled veteran-owned business. 54 A. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no public body shall discriminate against a bidder or offeror because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, status as a service disabled 55 veteran, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment. Whenever 56 solicitations are made, each public body shall include businesses selected from a list made available by 57 the Department of Minority Business Enterprise. 58

B. All public bodies shall establish programs consistent with this chapter to facilitate the participation

60 of small businesses and businesses owned by women, minorities, and service disabled veterans in procurement transactions. The programs established shall be in writing and shall comply with the 61 provisions of any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection 62 63 \overline{C} or, where applicable, by the chief executive of a local governing body pursuant to § 15.2-965.1, and 64 shall include specific plans to achieve any goals established therein. State agencies shall submit annual 65 progress reports on small, women-women-owned, and minority-owned business procurement and on 66 service disabled veteran-owned business procurement to the Department of Minority Business Enterprise in a form specified by the Department of Minority Business Enterprise. The Department of Minority 67 Business Enterprise shall make information on service disabled veteran-owned procurement available to 68 69 the Department of Veterans Services upon request.

70 C. Whenever there exists (i) a rational basis for small business enhancement or (ii) a persuasive analysis that documents a statistically significant disparity between the availability and utilization of 71 women-women-owned and minority-owned businesses, the Governor is authorized and encouraged to 72 73 require state agencies to implement appropriate enhancement or remedial measures consistent with 74 prevailing law.

75 D. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no state agency, department or institution shall 76 discriminate against a bidder or offeror because the bidder or offeror employs ex-offenders unless the 77 state agency, department or institution has made a written determination that employing ex-offenders on 78 the specific contract is not in its best interest. 79

E. As used in this section:

80 "Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident 81 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:

1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and 82 83 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

84 2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China, 85 86 Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of the 87 Pacific, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, or Sri Lanka and who is regarded as such by the community of 88 which this person claims to be a part.

95 "Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one or more 96 minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership 97 interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or 98 99 more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and 100 daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals.

"Service disabled veteran" means a veteran who (i) served on active duty in the United States 101 102 military ground, naval, or air service, (ii) was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable, and (iii) has a service-connected disability rating fixed by the United States Department of 103 104 Veterans Affairs.

"Service disabled veteran business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one 105 106 or more service disabled veterans or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, 107 108 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more individuals who are 109 service disabled veterans and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one 110 or more individuals who are service disabled veterans.

"Small business" means a business located in Virginia that is at least 51 percent independently 111 112 owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees, or annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less 113 114 averaged over the previous three years that meets the size standards established by the Administrator of the U.S. Small Business Administration pursuant to the federal Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. § 631 et 115 116 seq.), as amended, and relevant regulations promulgated thereto. One or more of the individual owners shall control both the management and daily business operations of the small business. A small business 117 118 is located in Virginia if the business has been organized pursuant to Virginia law or maintains a principal place of business within Virginia. 119

"State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other unit of state government. "State agency" shall not include any county, city, or town. 120 121

122 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one or more 123 women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or 124 limited liability company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is 125 owned by one or more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management 126 and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women.
