9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 53.1-40.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 53.1-40.01. Conditional release of geriatric prisoners.
12	Any person serving a sentence imposed upon a conviction for a felony offense, other than a Class 1
13	felony, (i) who has reached the age of sixty five 65 or older and who has served at least five years of
14	the sentence imposed or (ii) who has reached the age of sixty 60 or older and who has served at least ten 10 years of the sentence imposed may petition the Parole Board shall be eligible for consideration
15 16	for conditional release by the Parole Board. The Parole Board shall promulgate regulations to implement
17	the provisions of this section.
18	[ 2. That the Parole Board shall submit a report to the Chairman of the Senate Committee on
19	Rehabilitation and Social Services not later than December 1, 2012 on (i) the number of
20	individuals considered for conditional release pursuant to § 53.1-40.01 of the Code of Virginia; (ii)
21	the number of such individuals actually conditionally released; and (iii) the number of individuals
22	conditionally released who are subsequently arrested and recommitted to the Department of
