VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 2.2-2235 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Virginia Economic 3 Development Partnership Authority; board of directors; membership.

Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 2.2-2235 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 2.2-2235. Board of directors; members and officers; Chief Executive Officer.

9 The Authority shall be governed by a board of directors consisting of the Lieutenant Governor, the 10 Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry, the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, the Secretary of Finance, the Secretary of Technology, and the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College System, or their 11 designees, serving as ex officio, voting members, and 18 members to be appointed as follows: (i) one 12 13 from each congressional district in the Commonwealth and one citizen at large, appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly; (ii) four citizens at large appointed by the 14 15 Speaker of the House; and (iii) two citizens at large appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules. The six citizens appointed by the General Assembly shall reside in regions of the Commonwealth that have a 16 17 higher unemployment rate than that of the statewide average unemployment rate as reported by the Virginia Employment Commission for the preceding four years from the date of appointment. Ex officio 18 19 members of the Board shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Four of the 12 directors initially appointed by the Governor shall be appointed for terms of two and one-half years, three for 20 21 terms of four and one-half years, and five for terms of six and one-half years, from the effective date of their appointment; and thereafter the terms of members of the Board shall be six years. No member 22 23 shall be eligible to serve more than two terms; however, after the expiration of the term of a member 24 appointed to serve three years or less, two additional terms may be served if appointed thereto. Any 25 appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the unexpired term. A person appointed to fill a vacancy may 26 be appointed to serve two additional terms. Members of the Board shall receive their expenses and shall 27 be compensated at the rate provided in § 2.2-2104 for each day spent on the business of the Board.

28 The Board shall elect from its membership a chairman and a vice-chairman, and shall also elect a 29 secretary and a treasurer, who need not be members of the Board, and may also elect other subordinate 30 officers, who need not be members of the Board. The Board may also form committees and advisory 31 councils, which may include representatives who are not members of the Board, to undertake more 32 extensive study and discussion of the issues before the Board.

33 A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of the Authority's business, and 34 no vacancy in the membership shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise the rights and perform all 35 duties of the Authority.

The Board shall appoint the chief executive officer of the Authority, who shall not be a member of 36 37 the Board, whose title shall be President and Chief Executive Officer and may be referred to as the President or as the Chief Executive Officer, and who shall serve at the pleasure of the Board and carry 38 39 out such of the powers and duties conferred upon him by the Board.
