6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 9 of Title 18.2 a section
7	numbered 18.2-415.1, relating to disruption of a funeral or memorial service; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 9 of Title 18.2 a
10	section numbered 18.2-415.1 as follows:
11	§ 18.2-415.1. Disruption of a funeral or memorial service.
12	A. A person may not address speech to a person attending a funeral or memorial service that is
13	reasonably likely to provoke an imminent breach of the peace.
14	B. A person may not engage in picketing activity within 250 feet of a funeral or memorial service
15	that is targeted at one or more persons attending the funeral or memorial service.
16	C. This section does not apply to a person who conducts a funeral or memorial service.
17	D. A person who violates a provision of this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
