6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 63.2-607.1, relating to TANF
7	eligibility; drug-related felonies.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 63.2-607.1 as follows:
10	§ 63.2-607.1. Eligibility for TANF; drug-related felonies.
11	A person who is otherwise eligible to receive TANF assistance shall be exempt from the application
12	of § 115(a)(1) of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L.
13	104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely because he has been convicted of a felony
14	offense of possession of a controlled substance in violation of § 18.2-250, provided such person is not
15	engaged in the use of illegal drugs and he complies with, or has already complied with, all obligations
16	imposed by the criminal court and the Department; is actively engaged in or has completed a substance
17	abuse treatment program; and participates in drug screenings conducted at least once every three
18	months, or more frequently if there is reason to believe the individual may be engaged in the use of
19	illegal drugs.
