- 234567 A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-749.7:3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates for promoting tourism on Virginia's Eastern Shore; fees. 8
 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 9 1. That § 46.2-749.7:3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 10 § 46.2-749.7:3. Special license plates promoting tourism on Virginia's Eastern Shore; fees.
- 11 A. On receipt of an application therefor and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates promoting tourism on Virginia's Eastern Shore. 12
- B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed 13 fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to 14
- this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 15 16 as the Eastern Shore Tourism Fund established within the Department of Accounts. These funds shall be
- 17 paid annually to the Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce Foundation and used to support promoting
- tourism in Virginia's Eastern Shore. All other fees imposed under the provisions of this section shall be 18
- paid to, and received by, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles and paid by him into 19
- the state treasury and set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the necessary expenses incurred by 20 the Department of Motor Vehicles. 21
- 22 2. That the provisions of this act will not take effect unless and until the Eastern Shore Chamber
- of Commerce Foundation is established prior to July 1, 2012. 23
- 3. All license plates issued pursuant to § 46.2-749.7:3 of the Code of Virginia prior to July 1, 2012, 24 shall be valid until their expiration but shall be renewed thereafter under the provisions of this 25 act. 26
