WHEREAS, prior to the opening of the 2011 Special Olympics World Summer Games, Jennifer Ruley had the opportunity to meet Dr. Jill Biden, wife of Vice President Joe Biden, who attended the games as part of a presidential delegation; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Ruley had great fun meeting fellow competitors from different countries and demonstrated her prowess at bocce by capturing a silver medal in bocce singles, bocce doubles, and the bocce team competition; and

WHEREAS, a talented bocce player and inspiring role model, Jennifer Ruley proudly represented Churchville, the Commonwealth, and the nation at the 2011 Special Olympics World Summer Games; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly commend and congratulate Jennifer Ruley on her outstanding Special Olympics bocce career and her exemplary performance in Athens, Greece, at the 2011 Special Olympics World Summer Games; and, be it
